Highlights include *RECESS: A Second Saturday* teen takeover where PTAC turned the terrace of the museum into a giant board game, *Shorts!*, a mobile teen film festival at Superfine! Art Fair during Miami Art Week, Space Prom, Intergenerational Workshop: Teens as Teachers- a workshop focused on the ongoing tragedy of school shootings and *Viewports*, a teen convening consisting of an educator workshop, activities, and panel discussions on teens, technology, & contemporary art.

Lead Teaching Artist, September 2014- May 2018

As a lead teaching artist I wore many hats and participated in most of the educational programs of the museum. Duties on a typical day could be anywhere from designing interdisciplinary art-making for teacher workshops, enticing critical thinking through inquiry based tours serving 18,000 children a school year, or leading and training a team of talented teaching artists. Ultimately the position had me spending a great deal of time in galleries connecting the collection to the public.
